This one claims that the thimerosal causes tics and should be removed from all vaccines including those continuing to be used in Third World countries as it "carries an unjustifiable and excessive EtHg exposure with an unnecessary risk of neurotoxicity to the developing brain"

Number of antigens in early childhood vaccines and neuropsychological outcomes at age 7-10 years. Iqbal, Barile, Thompson & DeStefano 2013 (CDC) [FULL TEXT](#)

This one compares more than 1,000 children receiving different amounts of antigens 7,266 ... 8,127 ... or 10,341 by age 2 and finds that there is no difference in neurological outcome ... this is kinda like comparing the smoking of one pack or 1 ½ packs of cigarettes on cancer outcome and finding "no difference." They did NOT compare with those receiving NONE.

The automated Vaccine Safety Datalink showed a "consistent significantly increased rate" for autism, tics, adhd, etc. to exposure to mercury-containing vaccines. They conclude vaccines should be continued and further studies should be done. (HOW can they think that autism is an acceptable trade-off for measles?)

This is another one that compared amounts of mercury received based on number of DPT shots received by 6 months (ignoring those received later and those who received NONE) ... they could not rule out tics as an outcome in spite of obvious effort to do so.

That is all I can find in Medline. I would have expected a lot more research on this ... People on the "Stop Mandatory Vaccine" facebook group say their doctors have told them that tics are NORMAL after vaccination. (One said his son's TS went away after 22 years of tics when he detoxed heavy metals for 2 years.)
